Course Overview

The course is designed to provide delegates with the skills required to safely deal in a spillage situation from the planning, execution through to the correct disposal of any spent materials. They will be required to demonstrate their own ability through simulated incidents; delegates will gain valuable knowledge in dealing with spillages without exposing individuals to hazardous situations.
