**Course Overview**

The course is designed for any individual who requires knowledge of Permit to work systems. The course will provide an overview of the legislation involved, the situations where PTW should be used, the controls required to be putting place to allow an individual to work safely without putting themselves or others at risk.

This course is designed to provide the correct information to anyone required to assess the requirements of a particular job or task, and ensure that Permit to Work documentation is completed correctly - and that employees undertaking hazardous activities are competent to do so safely.
