Safe use of Woodworking equipment Eco37	1 day

Course Overview

The course will provide delegates with an Awareness of the legislation which applies to the Woodworking Industry and the hazards associated there in, including specific risks eg. Contact with moving machinery, noise and dust and when safe systems of work are relevant.

Who Should Attend

Any delegate who operates woodworking equipment.

Other Requirements (e.g. Equipment needed)

Any delegates with special needs should alert these to the company prior to attending training e.g dyslexia to allow time for the necessary arrangements to be put in place.

Course Content

1. Introduction to equipment and dangers/specific risks associated with it (equipment covered can be identified within training records)
2. Basic Safety checks to ensure equipment is safe prior to use
3. Understand how to set up machinery prior to use
4. Understand what action to take if equipment is thought to be defective/dangerous.
5. Understand legislation covering wood working machinery
6. Understand health effects associated with wood working machinery e.g. wood dust, noise vibration, Electricity
7. Daily inspection procedures
8. Authorization to operate
9. Understand the benefit of guards and safety devices and when and where they should be employed to reduce or eliminate the risk of injury
10. Understand the need to employ techniques/equipment to provide work piece support and when its necessary
11. Understand the need for safe system of work and when to employ them
12. Understand the need for warning signs and that the information contained within should be followed

Course Outcome

Successful delegates who pass the end of session assessment will receive an EcoSafety certificate.
