IOSH Working Safely (Eco42)	1 DAY

Course Overview

The IOSH Working Safely course is designed for candidates from any business sector who have no supervisory or managerial responsibilities who need an understanding of health & Safety at work.

IOSH's one-day Working safely course, has now been recognised by CSCS as an equivalent to a Level 1 Award in health and safety in a construction environment. It means that delegates who successfully complete Working safely can apply for a CSCS green Labourer card once they have also passed the CITB Health, Safety and Environment Operatives Test.

Who Should Attend

People at any level, in any sector, needing a grounding in the essentials of health and safety.

Other Requirements (e.g. Equipment needed)

None.

Course Content

By the end of the course delegates will have a knowledge of:

- carry out work activities without risk to themselves or others and understand the consequences if they fail to work safely
- identify hazards, risks and risk controls and understand the importance of risk assessment with examples of everyday use of risk assessment
- take appropriate workplace precautions and understand their importance in the work environment
- identify lines of communication in their places of work
- identify safety signs and signals
- know-how and to whom to report accidents, incidents and near misses in their places of work

- Chemical safety

- Accident prevention

Delegates must sit a short closed-book assessment at the end of the day where they will complete a multiple choice assessment and three hazard spotting assessment papers.

On successful completion the candidate will be awarded an IOSH Working Safely certificate which is valid for a period of three years when refresher training is recommended
