ITC Certificate in Emergency First Aid at work SCQF Level 5 (R26304)	1 DAY

Course Overview

This course is designed to provide the delegates with the essential basic skills and knowledge required to administer emergency first aid at work. To be provide awareness of the recording and reporting requirements for all accident and essentially what process to follow in the case of an emergency.

Who Should Attend

Any individual within the organization who may require an understanding of basic first aid in the workplace. Candidate must be 16 years if age or over.

Other Requirements (e.g. Equipment needed)

Delegates must wear suitable comfortable clothing as much of the course involves practical exercises, role play and injury simulations.

Any delegates with special needs should alert these to the company prior to attending training e.g dyslexia to allow time for the necessary arrangements to be put in place.

Course Content

The course syllabus covers the following as laid down by the Health & Safety (First Aid) Regulations 1981:

- What to do in an emergency/first aid priorities.
- Managing incidents.
- Basic Life Support.
- Examination of a casualty.
- Cardiopulmonary resuscitation.
- First Aid for the unconscious casualty.
- First Aid for the wound or bleeding.
- Dealing with burns or scalds.
- Treatment for shock.
- First Aid Equipment.
- Employers risk assessment of first aid needs.
- Regulations.
- Recording and reporting.

Course Outcome

Successful delegates will receive an SQA accredited first certificate issued by ITC First Aid which is valid for a three year period.
